

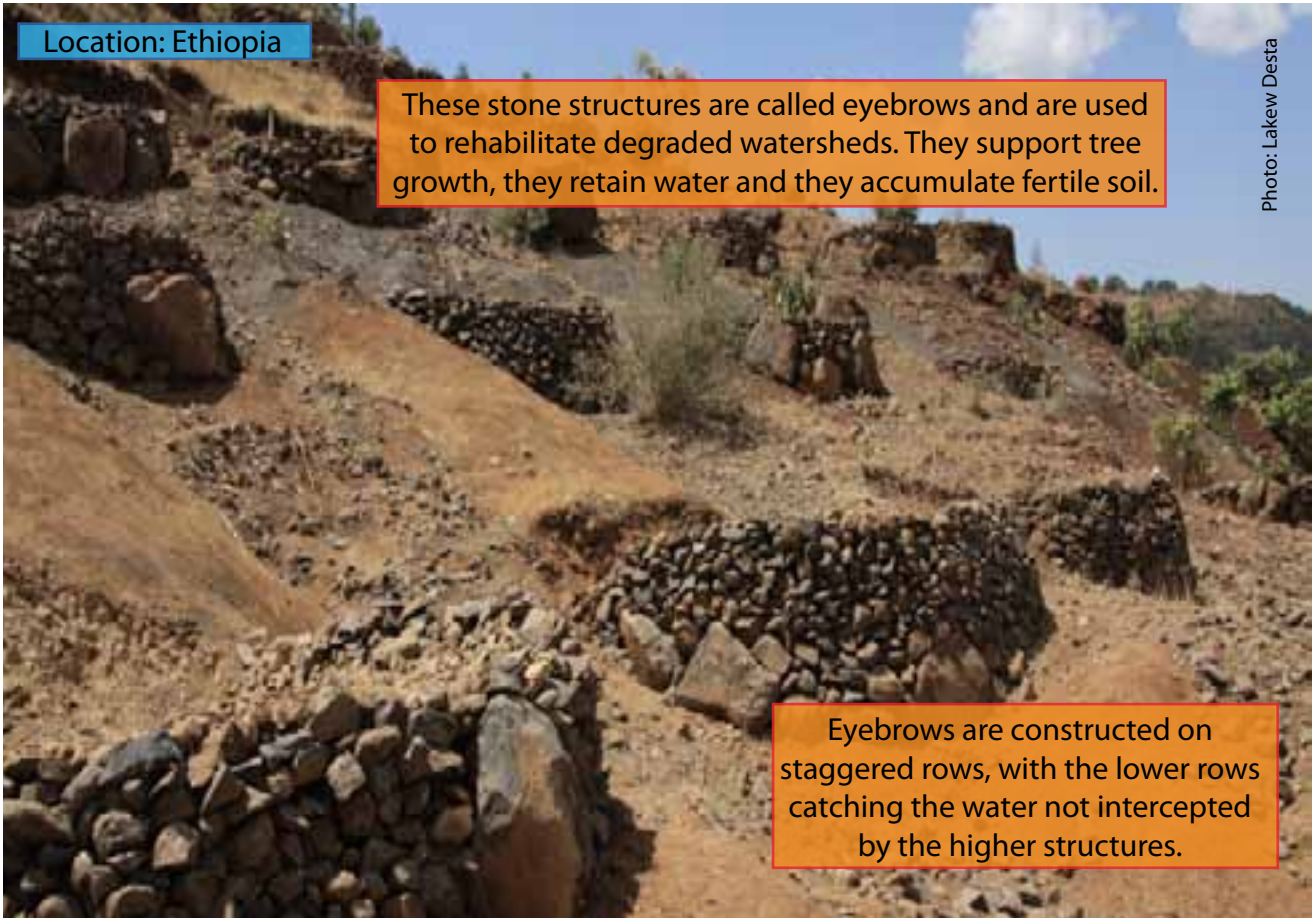
What do you see?

These stone structures are called eyebrows and are used to rehabilitate degraded watersheds. They support tree growth, they retain water and they accumulate fertile soil.

Eyebrows are constructed on staggered rows, with the lower rows catching the water not intercepted by the higher structures.
